**NYS ELECTION LAW SECTION 3-110
NOTICE TO ALL EMPLOYEES
WHO ARE REGISTERED VOTERS**

If you require working time off to vote, you may take off up to three (3) hours at the beginning or end of your shift, with pay, to allow you time to vote.

You must notify your supervisor not less than two (2) working days before the day of the election that you will need to take time off.

This notice shall be conspicuously posted in the place of work where it can be seen as employees come or go to their place of work not less than ten (10) working days before any election day and remain posted until the close of the polls on Election Day, June 25, 2019.
